Absolutely no refunds after March 1, 2019. BEGIN TERMS: When you place an order for bees you agree to the following terms.

Refunds or changes on Bee orders will be charged a \$35.00 cancellation or date change fee on each Package. No refunds or cancellations are allowed after March 1, 2019. Package bees that are not picked up on weekend dates selected will be forfeited unless special arrangements have been made. Bees are never shipped, however, shipping options form must be completed in order to process online ordering form. Bees must be picked up at the beekind store in Sebastopol, CA. Package bees that are not picked up on weekend dates selected will be forfeited unless special arrangements have been made. Orders must be made, and paid for, in advance of pick up dates, as we will sell out. Acknowledgement that weather can affect delivery dates.

PACKAGE BEES: Your pick up weekend must be selected at time of purchase. You can pick up your package(s) EITHER on Saturday or Sunday of your selected weekend. Pick up times are 10 am to 6pm on Saturday and Sunday only of your pre-selected weekend only. CUSTOMER ASSUMES ALL RISKS CONCERNING THEIR BEES ONCE THEY ARE PICKED UP. BEES ARE LIVE STOCK AND ARE SUBJECT TO VARIOUS ENVIRONMENTAL STRESSES AND OCCASIONALLY BEES DO DIE IN TRANSPORT OR ABSCOND AFTER INSTALLATION. END TERMS.

Equipment at Beekind is ten-frame capacity, however, as is our standard practice, we replace the outermost frames with follower boards for added insulation for bees.

HIVE CONFIGURATION

We suggest you purchase bees and equipment according to your needs and goals. Keeping honeybees can be accomplished in either deep or medium boxes or combinations of both.

A package of bees starts out in one box for 3 to 6 weeks and needs additional boxes after starting. A NUC will need add-ons sooner. Be sure to provide room for the colony to grow and prevent overcrowding & then swarming.

ALL EQUIPMENT LISTED HERE IS FOR TEN FRAME LANGSTROTH HIVE SET UPS

A brood box is the first in a series of boxes used to establish a honeybee colony's home. Using two deep hive bodies or three medium supers combine to make up a complete brood chamber. Medium hive bodies are traditionally used as honey boxes. In addition to the brood chamber, assume providing two extra supers for honey production in a California urban or coastal climate.

Consider making summer splits to propagate bees/create new colonies and healthy new queens and see "Summer Splits" on youtube by Doug Vincent.

Basic set ups include only the hive equipment that you need to start a colony of bees in the first month only. This list will help you get started, and as you need, we have more supplies at the store (see below).

BEST PRACTICE NEEDS for per colony start-up & growth, year one see below:

For brood chamber and starting bees

One completely assembled Basic Hive Set up (Deep or Medium), One additional deep hive body, if using deeps (OR two additional medium hive bodies if using mediums), tools and Gear.

For honey production readiness

Two additional medium hive bodies (minimum one) for collecting honey over brood chamber during nectar flows.

Feeding Bees

is important when establishing a colony in boxes for the first time and during times of severe nectar dearth. Feeding bees a mixture of sugar water of 1 part pure cane sugar to 1 part fresh water helps the new colony build wax combs which is essential for egg production and storage of pollen and nectar. You will need approximately 20 lbs of sugar (non-organic) to establish a package of bees.

Winter feeding (for bees unable to build stores) the ratio is 2 parts sugar to 1 part water. There are several different types of feeders available. When starting a package for the first couple of weeks, we advise using a simple entrance feeder with jar. For NUCS or established bees: an inside feeder is simple to use and very effective.

<i>Rectangular Plastic feeder with central access for bees. Must be used with basic traditional inner cover.</i>	

MANN LAKE INSIDE TOP FEEDER (MLFEED)	\$28.25
<i>Wood with plastic liner inside feeder with screened access to make it easy for keepers to feed from top without direct exposure to bees</i>	

ALL WOOD TOP FEEDER (WTF)	\$50.50
<i>All wood. Provides easy access and bees to feed inside. Acts as an insulating roof during the heat and cold. MUST USE FLOATS</i>	

WOOD FLOATS (WF)	\$1.50
<i>Floats keep bees from drowning in wood feeder feeding chamber. Provides insulation in winter months</i>	

BASIC TELESCOPING COVER (TELE)	\$29.25
<i>Flat top cover extends over hive to protect from weather</i>	

GARDEN HIVE TELESCOPING COVER (CT)	\$81.50
<i>Decorative A-Frame copper type cover extends over hive to protect from weather</i>
